Designate October 10th as Black Brewers Day

Joint Sponsor: Rep. Brewer

Bill Updates:

HB 253: Designate the General Charles Young Memorial Historical Corridor

Joint Sponsor: Representative Holmes

This bill was passed out of the House Transportation Committee and waits for a vote on the House floor

HB 221: Expand Postconviction Relief for DNA showing actual innocence

Joint Sponsor: Rep. Schmidt
