What's Happening?

New Bills:

HB 325: Requires all jails and prisons to provide communication devices for inmates who are deaf, hard of hearing or severely speech impaired

This proposed legislation aims to mandate municipal and county correctional facilities, as well as state correctional institutions, to provide inmates who are deaf, hard of hearing, or severely speech impaired with access to teletypewriters (TTY). TTY will enhance their communication capabilities within the correctional system. This bill is awaiting a committee assignment.
