Modifies the offense of grooming by prohibiting a person	14
who is 18 years or older from engaging in a pattern of conduct	15
with a minor who is less than 16 years of age and who is four or	16
more years younger than the person, instead of with a minor who	17
is 13 years or older but less than 16 years of age and who is	18
four or more years younger than the person, under the	19
circumstances specified in the bill.	20
Revises the penalties for a violation of the above	21
prohibition as follows:	22
-- Fifth degree felony if the victim is under 13 years of	23
age.	24
-- Fourth degree felony if the victim is under 13 years of	25
age and the offender previously has been convicted of or pleaded	26
guilty to grooming or a sexually oriented offense or a child-	27
victim oriented offense or the offender supplied alcohol or a	28
drug of abuse to the victim.	29
Revises the penalties for a violation of the prohibition	30
prohibiting a person who is 18 years or older from engaging in a	31
pattern of conduct with a minor under the circumstances	32
specified in the bill if the person and the minor are in any of	33
the relationships described for the offense of sexual battery,	34

-- Third degree felony if the victim is less than 13 years	36
of age and if the offender previously has been convicted of or	37
