
Jack and Jill of America Visits the

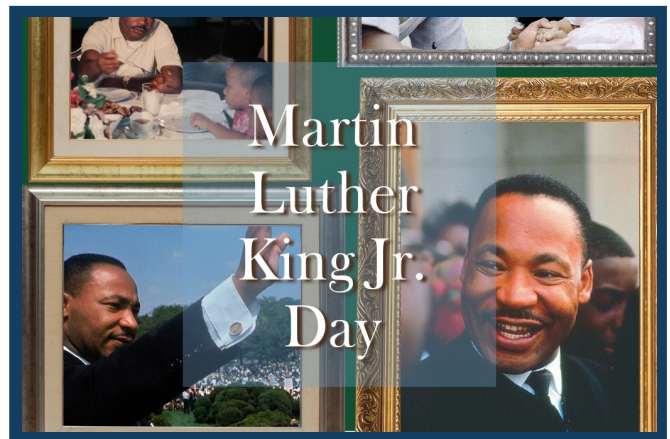
