Spotlight: Continuing to Fight for Commonsense Gun Safety

Today, August 4th, marks three years since nine people were murdered and 17 more were injured in a mass shooting in Dayton. I honor their memories today and everyday by fighting for basic, commonsense gun safety bills in Ohio. My colleagues in the Houses have introduced many, including:

- HB 38 (West, Miller, A.) Repeal "Stand Your Ground";
• HB 259 (Robinson, Miller, A.) Universal background checks;
• HB 274 (Upchurch, Jarrells) Restore local control to regulate firearms-related conduct;
• HB 257 (Russo, Smith, M.) Enact Extreme Risk Protection Order Act ("Red Flag" law);
• HB 262 (Miranda, Kelly) Prohibit negligent firearm storage;
• HB 360 (Miranda, Smith) Designate Gun Violence Awareness Month;
• HB 661 (Crossman, Hicks-Hudson) Require gun trigger locks with firearm sales



This comprehensive strategy is bolstered by the recent passage of the Bipartisan Safer Communities Act, the most significant gun violence reduction legislation to pass Congress in 30 years.

Meanwhile, Ohio Republicans continue to push legislation such as permit-less concealed carry, repealing duty to notify law enforcement, and kill at will. These extreme bills put our law enforcement and communities in danger.

Everyone deserves to feel safe in their homes and in their communities. Gun violence is a public health issue, and it deserves our attention and our action. We owe it to Ohio's children and families who deserve to go to school, the grocery store, and houses of worship without fearing for their lives.
