Happy Black History Month! This month we celebrate the incredible history of Black Americans, as well as look to the future and ask ourselves how we can continue to fight for and uplift the voices of our neighbors.

The 135th General Assembly is well underway in Columbus. Work has begun on various bills that will be debated and voted on in committee as well as on the floor of the House. On January 31, Governor Mike DeWine gave his 2023 State of the State speech, outlining his priorities for Ohio. Democrats are optimistic about several initiatives that will improve the lives of Ohioans, but the governor did not mention how the state plans to prevent gun violence or how we can ensure that all children receive a quality public education with adequate funding, regardless

Legislative Update

My colleagues have not wasted any time introducing great bills this GA, and I have already had the chance to sign on as a co-sponsor to a number of them. While these have not yet received bill numbers or committee assignments, they should in the coming days. Here are a few I've signed on to recently:

- "Student Mental Health Act" to allow K-12 students to take up to 3 mental health days
- "Menstrual Equity Act" to require corrections facilities to supply sufficient menstrual products to incarcerated women
- Create the Ohio Asian American and Pacific Islander (AAPI) Affairs Commission
- Expand Ohio's **Homestead Tax** Exemption for seniors
- "Veterans Opportunity Tax Credit" for employers that hire veterans
- Prohibition on oil and gas drilling in Lake Erie
