The First Quarter of the 134th General Assembly is over. The House and Senate passed the Transportation Budget, which creates jobs and includes a provision to help protect public transportation in Toledo. Next up is the Operating Budget, which will provide funding for our schools, public assistance, and other government services. The deadline in Ohio Law to pass the Operating Budget is July 1st, so stayed tuned.

In Mid March, President Biden signed the American Rescue Plan which will help our country build back better after the COVID-19 pandemic devastation. The damage was broad and widespread so the \$1.9 trillion package touched on many aspects of America to ensure everyone receives the help they deserve. Here at the Statehouse, the Legislature passed Amended Sub. Senate Bill 18, which incorporated changes from the Federal Tax Code included in the American Rescue Plan to help Ohioans. As Ranking Member of the House Ways and Means Committee, I had the privilege of working with colleagues on both sides of the aisle to push for changes to help Ohio. Thanks to the American Rescue Plan, Ohioans who received Unemployment Benefits last year received tax relief on the first \$10,200 in UI/PUA benefits. The American Rescue Plan also expanded the Child and Dependent Care Tax Credit and the Earned Income Tax Credits. These tax credits help our middle and working class. The law provides relief for teachers who purchased Personal Protection Equipment to protect themselves and their students, as well as help for small businesses.
