State Operating Budget

The Ohio House of Representatives recently passed the State Operating Budget for fiscal years 2024-25. The state operating budget is a two-year budget that funds the operation of state agencies and programs.

The budget lowers taxes for all Ohioans. Not only does this budget further flatten, simplify, and make more permanent the state income tax into two brackets, it provides safeguards for vulnerable Ohio populations. The budget includes House language that indexes the homestead exemption to inflation, ensuring that those living on fixed incomes are protected from increases in property taxes. This will allow seniors and disabled veterans to maintain financial stability and stay in their homes.

The budget also invests \$16 million to enhance childcare infrastructure, aiming to improve the availability and quality of childcare services, enabling parents to work or pursue education while their children receive appropriate care. An investment in Ohio children is an investment in the future of our state for generations to come.

I'm proud of this budget and the way the Ohio House continues to invest in the betterment of our great state.
