I am optimistic about the future of our state and excited to continue working for you and your family, both in the halls of the Statehouse and throughout our community.



State Representative Humphrey's Year in Review

During the 135th General Assembly, Representative Humphrey successfully advanced legislation that prioritizes people and works toward the betterment of individuals from diverse backgrounds and communities. Key legislative efforts include:

- Strong Foundations Act (HB 7)
- Triple Negative Breast Cancer Awareness Month (HB 28)
- Driver's License Suspensions for Failure to Pay Child Support (HB 29)
- Feminine Hygiene Products in Correctional Facilities (HB 30)
- Electronic Recordings of Parole Board Hearings (HB 44)
- Relief from Collateral Sanctions for Housing (HB 50)
- Limiting "No Duty to Retreat" Locations (HB 62)
- Conflict Resolution Instruction in Schools (HB 63)
- Adjusting Criminal Penalties for Drug Offenses (HB 83)
- Childcare Expenses Using Campaign Funds (HB 114)
- Employment Conditions for Registered Nurses (HB 154)
- Funding for SNAP, TANF, and WIC (HB 288)
- Amending Landlord and Tenant Law (HB 511)

This year, Representative Humphrey successfully had House Bill 50 signed into law. Additionally, HB 7, HB 28, HB 29, and HB 30 were passed by the House. Representative Humphrey also introduced several key bills—HB 44, HB 62, HB 63, HB 83, HB 154, HB 288, and HB 511—all designed to improve the lives of individuals and communities across Ohio.

Looking Ahead to 2025

As the General Assembly prepares for the coming year, Representative Humphrey remains committed to advocating for policies that put people over politics. Humphrey's focus will continue to be on ensuring that all Ohioans—regardless of race, gender, or economic status—have the freedom to live authentically, the dignity of safe communities and secure jobs, and the opportunity to thrive.

The past year has been marked by significant accomplishments under Representative Humphrey's leadership. In 2024, our office has:

- Assisted over 2,000 constituents through casework
- Hosted 15+ office hours and town halls
- Engaged with more than 3,000 phone calls, emails, and letters to constituents
- Secured \$3.3 million in capital funds for the district
