As you may know – the special election held in August with one single issue was defeated! The issue presented would have weakened the voice of the people at the ballot box by making it nearly impossible for citizen led initiatives to be considered and voted on. The issue was defeated by the majority of voters across the state of Ohio.

Now as a result, there are two ballot initiatives before us during the upcoming November 8th general election. These issues will be voted on by the citizens of Ohio and will have an enormous impact on our social, cultural, and civic lives. Voters will have an opportunity to decide whether they support the sale and usage of recreational marijuana. Additionally, voters will have an opportunity to protect the rights of Women and families by choosing to decide whether Women should have complete autonomy over their bodies and healthcare. Again, now is the time to exercise your right to vote and to voice your support of democracy by getting out to vote in support of your interests.
