Pathway Toledo can help with several programs that provide relief during the winter months:

- Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP) HEAP is a federally funded program that provides direct assistance to energy bills for those in need. Benefits are applied directly to customer's utility bills or bulk fuel bills.
- Winter Crisis Program the Winter Crisis Program offers help reconnecting or stopping disconnection of utility service, transferring services, or obtaining new service during the winter months.
- Call or visit their website to see if you qualify for these programs.

Programs that NeighborWorks Toledo helps with:

- Home Weatherization Assistance Program (HWAP) HWAP provides assistance to improve the energy efficiency of the homes of eligible Ohio residents.
- WarmChoice WarmChoice is provided by Columbia Gas of Ohio and assists with home energy efficiency. Possible energy efficiency services include: attic and wall insulation, air sealing, repair and/or replacement of natural gas appliances, water heater, and furnace.
