From Rep. Thomas' Desk:

Dear Neighbors,

In light of the ongoing federal government shutdown, please be advised that Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) recipients may not receive their November benefits as normally scheduled. Ohio has been informed by its SNAP benefits card (EBT) vendor that the USDA has confirmed SNAP recipients will still be able to access their existing benefits after October 31. However, the issuance of November benefits may be delayed if the shutdown continues. Any remaining benefits on the card can still be accessed.

For those who may need emergency food assistance during this time, I have compiled a list of six food distributions happening in District 25 this month. You can also find additional food distributions and foodbanks near you at the end of this page.

As always, please feel free to reach out to my office if you need any help. I will do my best to connect you with the resources you need. I understand these are difficult times for many, and I will continue to support our community however I can.
