#### Testifying at the Statehouse

In the month of November I had the opportunity to provide sponsor testimony on <u>two</u> of my bills - both in the House Commerce and Labor Committee.

I delivered sponsor testimony for **House Bill 537 - the Junk Fee Elimination Act**, with my joint sponsor Representative Munira Abdullahi of Columbus. The Junk Fee Elimination Act would require corporations to disclose all additional fees and their purposes.
