- ⇒ **HB** 352: Establish an Adverse Childhood Experiences Study Commission
- ⇒ **HB 360:** Designate August 14th as "Ukrainian Independence Day" in Ohio
- → **HB 372:** Requires vehicle operators to watch, listen, and stop for on-track equipment at railroad crossings
- ⇒ **HB 30:** Requires correctional facilities to supply feminine hygiene products
- ⇒ **HB** 50: Create mechanism to allow relief-collateral sanction for housing
