Before coming to the General Assembly, I built a strong career in community engagement and public service, working for more than 20 years as an Executive Administrative Assistant supporting C-suite level executives. While a student at Clark Atlanta University, I became a member of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. I continue to be committed to social issues as a member of this public service organization.

In 2019, I decided to run for public office and won a seat on Reynoldsburg City Council in a historic election. Representing Ward 4, I was elected council president in 2023. I leveraged my seat on council to update the city's zoning code, improve fair housing, build more affordable housing units in the city, declare racism in Reynoldsburg a public health crisis, and to establish the first official Juneteenth celebrations in the municipality.

My top priorities as a state representative will be to advocate for affordable and accessible housing and efficient infrastructure development statewide, free and fair education for all, and to support children and families.
