Dear Neighbor,

This summer I have been out in my district, meeting with local businesses, shadowing and discussing policy and issues with municipal leaders, and, most of all, advocating for you.

Something to be aware of is that Ohio is entering a mid-census congressional redistricting phase, caused by the expiration of the current maps which will happen next year. The legislature's Joint Committee on Congressional Redistricting is currently underway, panning and reviewing proposals on Ohio's congressional maps and fielding public testimony and input.

You, as citizens, can submit your own proposals for Ohio's congressional maps at redistricting.legislature.ohio.gov. I recommend doing so, not only to make your voice heard in this crucial process, but to communicate the voice of the people, which we as legislators should be considering when drawing your congressional districts.

The legislature will officially return from recess on Tuesday, September 30 and I am excited to get back to work! If you need any assistance or just want to make your voice heard to your state representative, my office can be reached at (614) 644-6002 or rep05@ohiohouse.gov.


