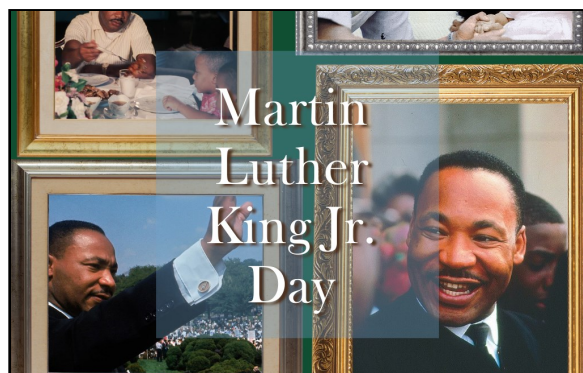

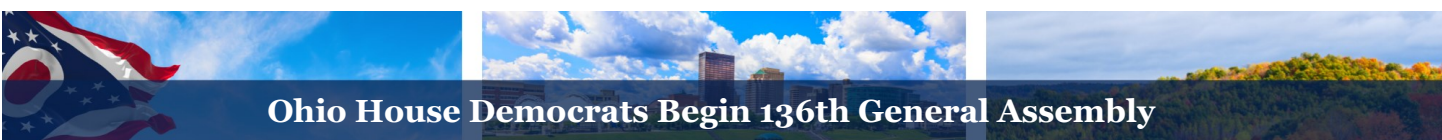

Ohio House Democrats Begin 136th General Assembly

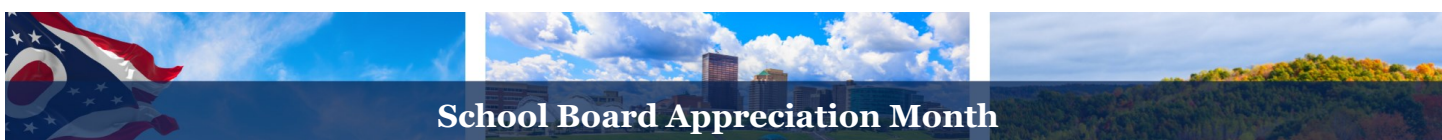
House Democrats are excited to begin the 136th General Assembly, prioritizing the betterment of individuals from different backgrounds and communities, putting YOU, the people, first.

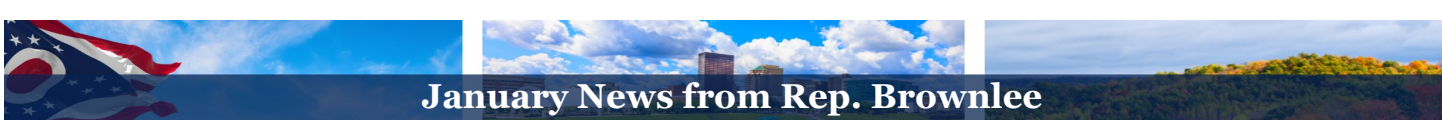
