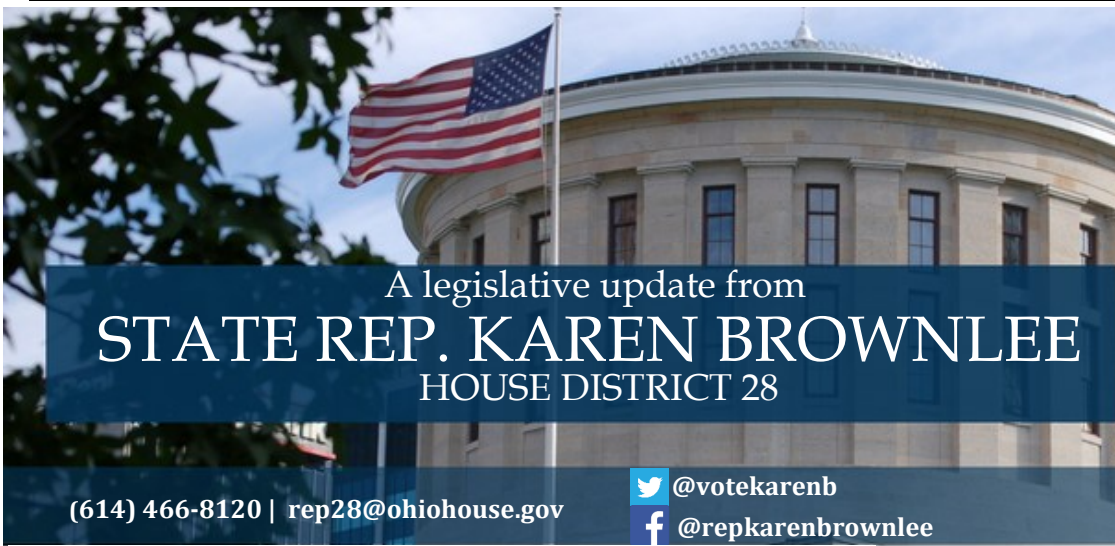




Dear Neighbor-

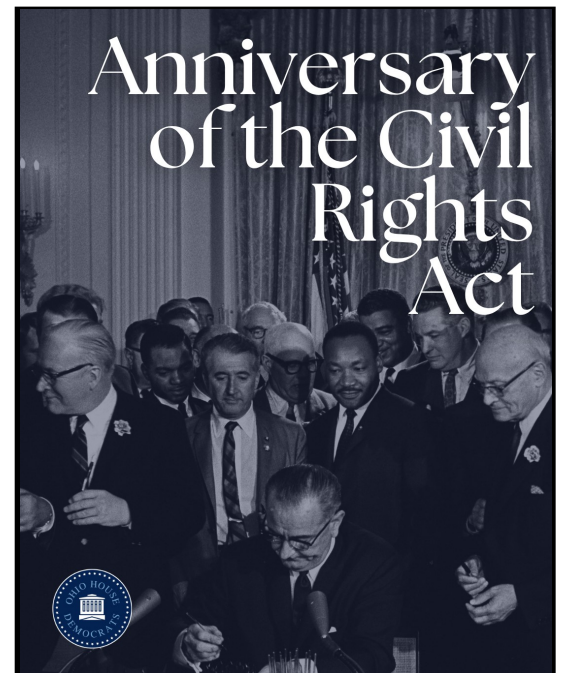

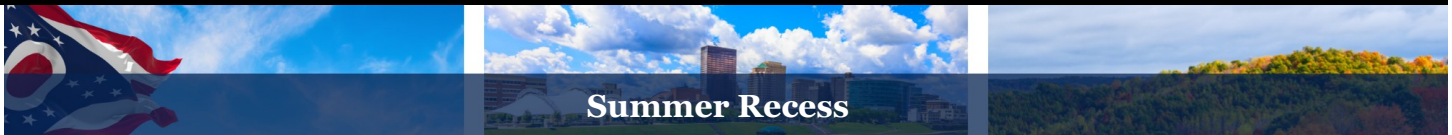
From Forest Park to Loveland; Springdale to Sycamore Township; Deer Park to Sharonville; let us stand together and look ahead to a future of freedom and equality.

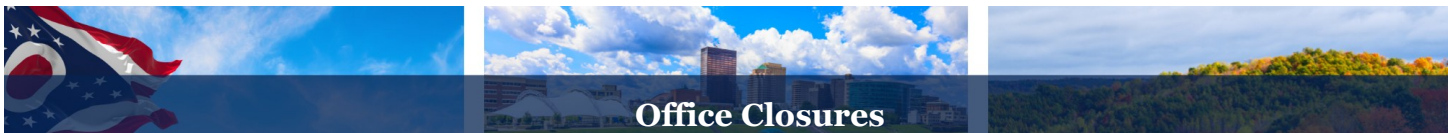


Summer Recess
