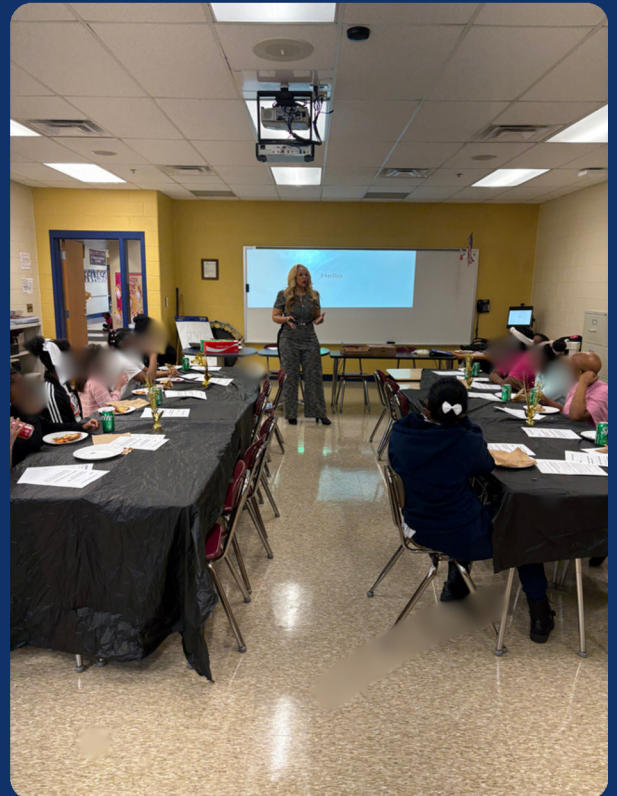
WORKING FOR YOU
